

Serial and Model Number Location Instruction Sheet

ATWOOD WATER HEATER

These numbers are located by opening the access door on the exterior of your coach. Inside that door, on the combustion housing there will be a white specification sticker. On that sticker you will find the model and serial number. The model number will begin with either a G or E. The serial number will begin with a "9" and will be 11 or 13 numeric digits long.

HYDRO-FLAME FURNACE

Locating the Model and Serial Numbers on most Atwood Furnaces is easy. To help you with this please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with the probable series of Atwood Furnace you might have. Most 7900/8000-II furnaces are installed in tent trailers and truck campers. Most 8500-IV and 2334 series furnaces are installed in the majority of Trailers, 5th Wheels and Motor Homes that Atwood provides heating systems for. 8900-III and 2540/1522 series furnaces are installed in large Class A Motor Homes, Bus's and or structures designed not too be moved.

If you have a 7900-II/8000-II series furnace you can locate the serial number by first removing the louvered door that covers the furnace. This will be found in the interior of your coach. The Serial Number Sticker is a White Sticker. This Sticker will be located on the front of your furnace directly below the Furnace Model Sticker. The sticker will be Labeled Atwood Mobile Products and the number will begin with S/N ##### all furnace serial numbers are 7 digits long. The Model Number is located on the Furnace Model Sticker this sticker is located on the black plastic housing that covers the electronics of your furnace.

To find the Serial Number and Model Number Stickers for the following furnace models please follow these instructions. For 8500-IV and 8900-III series furnaces, The model number and serial number stickers may be located by first removing or opening the access door too your furnace. This door will be located on the exterior of your Coach or Trailer. If your series of unit has a separate interior plastic cover covering the blower section of your furnace this cover will need to be folded down to reveal the two stickers. You will see a black plastic blower cover both stickers are located on this blower cover. The Serial Number sticker will be Labeled Atwood Mobile Products and the number will begin with S/N ##### all furnace serial numbers are 7 digits long. The Model Number is located on the Furnace Model Sticker this sticker is located on the black plastic blower housing.

IMPORTANT: Please follow these instructions for locating the Serial Number Sticker and Model Number Sticker for all furnace models that do not have access from the outside of your Coach or Trailer (7900/8000 not included). These Atwood Models are designed to be accessed from the interior of your coach. No outside door will be available or removable to gain this information. Atwood recommends in these situations you contact your selling dealer or nearest servicing dealer for assistance in providing your Serial Number and Model Number. When you are provided your Serial Number as with other Atwood Furnace models the Serial Number will be 7 digits but the Serial number will begin with the Prefix 2LD#####.

WEDGEWOOD RANGE

You will find these numbers by lifting the grates and range top. There is a data plate or sticker in this area. The information you are looking for is on this sticker. **Note:** If you have a "sealed burner" range it is not necessary to lift the top to obtain this information. Instead you can look through the slotted vent area located on the top of the range towards the back.
